Today, **Friday 25 September 2026**, is the last day to buy **MOONBEATS: AFTERDARK** tickets online at **S\$25**, Science Centre Singapore said. From Saturday, the one-night silent disco is **S\$35** at the door.

MOONBEATS runs in Hall A on **Saturday 26 September only**, from 7pm to 11pm. The Limited Duo Bundle is **S\$40**, and the S\$20 early bird tier is sold out. Every ticket includes one botanical non-alcoholic drink, the Celestial Trail and stargazing.

On Friday 25 and Saturday 26 September, the Omni-Theatre screens **Moon Legends: From Myth to Mission** at **S\$4**. Showtimes are 6pm, 6.40pm, 7.20pm, 8pm, 8.40pm and 9.20pm. Each ticket covers one show plus the trail and pavilion stargazing.
