



## Seoul And So At National Gallery Singapore: Korean BBQ Dining Guide

### Description

National Gallery Singapore now lists Seoul & So on Level 5 of the City Hall Wing, giving the museum a modern Korean BBQ option from the award-winning team behind Seoul Restaurant at Conrad Singapore Orchard.

The official page describes Seoul & So as the Rhee siblings's modern take on Korean BBQ, combining progressive innovation with traditional Korean cooking techniques. For diners, that makes it a more polished museum meal than a quick stop between exhibitions.

### Opening Hours And Location

The Gallery lists Seoul & So as open daily for lunch from 12pm to 3pm, with last order at 2pm, and dinner from 6pm to 10.30pm, with last order at 9.30pm. The location is City Hall Wing, Level 5.

That timing works well for visitors who want a proper meal before or after exhibitions, but it also means a casual museum walk-in may be harder during peak dinner periods. The page provides a reservation path through Seoul & So's own website and lists contact details for the restaurant.

## Who Should Book

This suits diners who want Korean BBQ in a quieter civic-district setting rather than a busy mall. It is also useful for date nights, gallery outings and small group meals around City Hall.

The Level 5 location also makes it practical for visitors who want to pair dinner with exhibitions, rooftop views or a National Gallery evening programme. If you are booking for a mixed-age group, check the menu format ahead of time because a polished Korean BBQ meal can be slower than a casual pre-show bite.

For office workers in the civic district, the lunch window is tighter because last order is 2pm. Dinner gives more breathing room, but the 9.30pm last-order timing still matters if you are arriving after an event at City Hall, Esplanade or Victoria Theatre.
