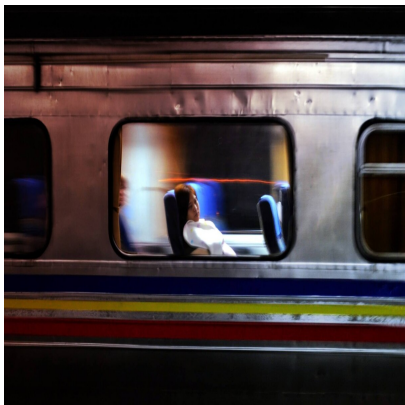




Shuttle Tebrau Guide: Timetable, Tickets and Border Timing

Description

The timetable effective in 2026 lists 13 daily Woodlands departures from 08:30 to 23:45 and 18 JB Sentral departures from 05:00 to 22:45. Each is scheduled for five minutes, but the trip plan must include check-in, Singapore and Malaysia clearance, station access and a missed-train buffer.

Start with the decision table

Situation	What it means
Woodlands morning choice	08:30, 09:45 or 11:00 are the first three listed departures
Woodlands evening choice	18:45, 20:00, 21:15, 22:30 or 23:45
JB Sentral early return	Services begin at 05:00 and run at close intervals in the morning
Train ride shown in timetable	Five minutes station to station
Passport details do not match booking	Correct before travel; passenger identity is not a casual field

Read the direction twice

ST72 onward in the timetable is Woodlands to JB Sentral, while ST61 onward is JB Sentral to Woodlands. [KTMB 2026 intercity timetable](#) shows different service counts and first trains. A correct time in the wrong direction is still a missed journey.

Five minutes is not door to door

The rail segment is scheduled for five minutes. Add the operator’s required arrival, immigration, walking and onward transport. At peaks, the station process can dominate the trip even when the train itself is punctual.

Book with the travel document

[KTMB Shuttle Tebrau ticket FAQ](#) requires the passenger and passport details used for travel. Do not buy for an unnamed replacement or assume a typo can be ignored at the gate. Recheck passport number, nationality and expiry before payment.

Pair outbound and return before paying

A day trip can fail if the outward train is available but the desired return is sold out. Hold a bus fallback and do not schedule a non-refundable Johor activity immediately after the nominal arrival.

Use the latest PDF and booking screen

Timetables and sale windows can change. The current PDF is the planning baseline; the official booking system controls live inventory, fare and boarding instructions on the chosen date.

Worked application

A traveller choosing the 08:30 Woodlands train should not plan an 08:35 Johor appointment merely because the scheduled arrival is 08:35. A 09:30 flexible appointment recognises clearance and walking risk. The extra 55 minutes is a planning buffer, not an operator requirement.

Action checklist

1. Open the latest KTMB timetable
2. Select direction before time
3. Book outbound and return together where possible
4. Enter passport details exactly
5. Save the ticket and current arrival instruction
6. Reach the correct station with a conservative buffer
7. Keep a bus or later-train fallback

Build a decision record another person can check

The useful output is not only an answer to “Shuttle Tebrau timetable 2026”. It is a small file showing why the answer fits this reader: a singapore traveller planning a day trip or commute to johor bahru. Record the fact that controls each step, the date it was true and the source or service that confirmed it. That matters because the task is to choose a train, book the correct direction and budget immigration time around the five-minute ride; a changed amount, date, person, address, venue, device or eligibility fact can change the result even when the general rule has not moved.

The record should be short enough to update. Put the most recent evidence first, keep the earlier version, and label estimates separately from confirmed figures. The two original tools in this guide—a direction-specific timetable digest with first, last and evening blocks and a border-time example separating a five-minute ride from a usable arrival—serve different purposes: one structures the choice, while the other tests the choice against a concrete case. Neither should be copied into a new case without refreshing its inputs.

Errors that change the outcome

- Reading JB-to-Woodlands times backwards
- Treating five minutes as total journey time
- Booking before checking return inventory
- Using a nickname or old passport number

- Promising an appointment at scheduled arrival time

How long is the scheduled train ride?

Five minutes between Woodlands and JB Sentral in the current timetable.

How many Woodlands departures are listed?

Thirteen daily, from 08:30 to 23:45.

Can I present a different passport?

Use the passport details required for the booking and correct any mismatch before travel.

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
