



## SIFA NOLI TIMERE 2026: Free Festival Work Across Singapore Venues

### Description

NOLI TIMERE is one of the free SIFA 2026 entries that can still fit into a late-May plan. SIFA lists the work from 15 to 30 May across various venues.

The programme credits Janet Echelman from the United States and Rebecca Lazier from Canada, placing it within SIFA's broader festival map rather than a single theatre run.

### Why It Is Worth Flagging

SIFA's 2026 programme is dense, and free works are useful for readers who want to sample the festival without committing to a ticketed evening. NOLI TIMERE sits in that category, with the listing showing free admission.

The festival page also connects NOLI TIMERE to a related free-with-pre-registration talk, *The Body as Sensing Technology: Creating NOLI TIMERE*, at Esplanade Black Room on 27 May.

### How To Approach It

Because the listing says various venues, check the day's festival map before heading out. This is the kind of festival work that benefits from pairing with another SIFA programme nearby rather than treating it as a standalone commute.

It is also a good option for readers who prefer public-space or movement-led works over a seated theatre slot.
