



Singapore Airlines Fare Sale Ends 9 August 2026: Fares From S\$208 to 63 Cities

Description

The **Singapore Airlines fare sale** is in its final days, and if a year-end escape or a 2027 long-haul trip is on your mind, this is the week to lock it in. Running from 14 July to 9 August 2026, the sale offers selected return fares from just **S\$208** across 63 destinations in Asia, Australia, New Zealand, Europe, Africa and North America, with outbound travel stretching all the way to 31 May 2027.

Bookings close on **Sunday, 9 August 2026**, so there is little time left to compare dates and grab a fare. Here is what the sale covers, the best economy prices from Singapore, and how to squeeze out a little more with card offers.

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What the Singapore Airlines fare sale covers

The promotion spans Economy, Premium Economy and Business Class, though the cabins on offer vary by route. The key dates to remember are simple: you must book between 14 July and 9 August 2026, and travel on selected dates from now until 31 May 2027. Blackout periods apply over peak travel windows, and every fare is subject to seat availability in the promotional booking class, so flexible dates will always give you the best shot at the lowest price.

Because outbound travel runs well into 2027, this sale is ideal for planning ahead, whether that is the June school holidays, a milestone anniversary or a long-delayed trip to see family.

Best economy fares from Singapore

Short hauls around Southeast Asia

The headline S\$208 fare is to Penang, with Kuala Lumpur close behind at S\$218. Ho Chi Minh City comes in at S\$258, while Medan, Phnom Penh and Phuket are each S\$268. For a beach reset, Denpasar (Bali) starts from S\$308, Manila from S\$338 and Bangkok from S\$378. These are the sweet spot of the sale for Singapore travellers who want a quick, fuss-free getaway.

North Asia favourites

Hong Kong leads the North Asia list at S\$358, followed by Taipei at S\$448 and Beijing at S\$468. Seoul and Busan sit higher at S\$608 and S\$628, so if Korea is on your list, it pays to test a few departure dates. If Japan is calling, remember to review the latest entry rules in our [guide to Japan travel rules for Singapore visitors](#) before you commit.

Australia and New Zealand

Australia is where the sale gets interesting for a longer holiday. Darwin starts from S\$568 and Perth from S\$688, with Melbourne and Sydney both from S\$798 and Brisbane from S\$868. New Zealand runs dearer, with Auckland from S\$1,628, so weigh up the travel dates carefully. If you are eyeing the west of Australia, our look at the new [Singapore Airlines Western Sydney flights from November 2026](#) is worth a read.

Europe and the Americas

Long-haul bargains include Milan and Rome from S\$1,188, London from S\$1,188 (for selected outbound travel in November 2026, otherwise from S\$1,288) and Paris from S\$1,188. Across the Pacific, Los Angeles starts from S\$1,208 and San Francisco from S\$1,198. These are strong economy prices for full-service, direct or one-stop travel, especially with the long booking runway to May 2027.

Premium Economy and Business Class deals

If you would rather travel up front, the sale has options too. Business Class to Kuala Lumpur starts from S\$978, Bali from S\$1,028 and Ho Chi Minh City from S\$1,088, while Hong Kong is from S\$1,998 and Bangkok from S\$1,338. Premium Economy is available on longer routes, with Hong Kong from S\$1,108, Delhi from S\$1,068 and Sydney from S\$2,178. For an overnight or red-eye, the extra legroom can be worth every dollar.

How to stretch your savings

Two card offers run alongside the sale. Eligible DBS and POSB cardholders can take **S\$50 off each adult return fare** using promo code **DBS50OFF**, booked directly on the Singapore Airlines website for return trips starting in Singapore and flown entirely by Singapore Airlines (up to two passengers per booking). The offer runs in short windows rather than continuously: the next one is 11 to 17 August 2026, followed by monthly releases through December 2026. Do note that these later windows do not extend the sale fares beyond 9 August, and their travel periods may differ, so read the terms before you book.

Mastercard holders can separately earn **S\$50 worth of KrisPay miles** on an eligible return or multi-city booking made during the sale, capped at the first 200 qualifying customers and requiring a minimum spend of S\$1,000 on a KrisFlyer UOB Mastercard or S\$1,200 on another Singapore-issued Mastercard. This one suits travellers flying imminently, as the eligible travel dates fall within the sale period itself.

Before you book

A few quick checks will save you grief later. Confirm the exact travel dates are available in the promotional fare class, watch for blackout periods over popular holidays, and read the fare conditions on changes and cancellations. Compare a couple of nearby dates, as a shift of a day or two can move the price noticeably. Also factor in checked baggage and seat selection, which sit outside the promotional fare. If you are flying soon, it is worth knowing that [Changi Airport's first satellite gate](#) has just opened, which may affect your walk to the aircraft.

Prefer to stay closer to home?

The bottom line

With fares from S\$208 and a booking deadline of 9 August 2026, this Singapore Airlines fare sale rewards travellers who plan ahead. Pin down your dates, layer on a card offer if you qualify, and book directly at singaporeair.com before the window closes. All fares quoted are starting prices in Singapore dollars and are subject to availability and the airline's terms.

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
