



Singapore Deals Round-Up (23 April 2026): Food Deals, Warehouse Sales, Beauty Bazaars And Banking Promotions

Description

Singapore's deal landscape is buzzing this week with a healthy mix of fast-food launches, dollar-priced convenience store bites, warehouse clearances, beauty bazaars, cruise roadshows and banking promotions. If you are hunting for the best value on your lunch break, weekend shopping or next holiday, this round-up gathers the most noteworthy offers currently running across the island as of Thursday, 23 April 2026.

Prices and availability are accurate at time of writing, but promotions can change quickly, so head to the relevant outlets or apps to confirm before you spend. Many of these deals are app-exclusive or require membership sign-up, so have your phone charged and your favourite loyalty apps ready.

Singapore deals round-up for 23 April 2026

Food And Beverage Deals Worth Queueing For

McDonald's Honey Mustard McCrispy: The fast-food giant's new Honey Mustard McCrispy Burger is back by popular demand, featuring crispy chicken thigh paired with a sweet-tangy honey mustard sauce, fresh lettuce and cheese. The burger is available from 24 April as part of an a la carte offering and within an Extra Value Meal. App users can score additional savings through the McDonald's app, where weekly coupons consistently knock a dollar or two off meal bundles.

Krispy Kreme Spring Up Series: Krispy Kreme Singapore has rolled out its floral-inspired Spring Up doughnut collection, featuring four new designs with pastel glazes and garden-themed toppings. The collection is priced at \$3.80 per piece or \$24 for a dozen, with a bundle promotion offering a second dozen at 50 per cent off when you purchase one dozen. The promotion is valid at all Krispy Kreme outlets except Changi Airport.

7-Eleven \$1 Snack Picks: 7-Eleven's rotating \$1 snack promotion is running again this week, with selected chips, chocolates and instant noodles priced at just \$1 each. The deal is available at all 7-Eleven outlets and is a lifesaver for late-night study sessions or quick hunger fixes between meetings.

Members of the 7-Rewards app can stack an additional 5 per cent off when paying via linked wallets.

Jack&??s Place \$6 Weekday Lunch: The long-running Western restaurant chain is offering its weekday set lunch from \$6 onwards at selected outlets. The lunch includes a main course, soup, bread roll and drink, making it one of the most affordable sit-down Western meals in the CBD. The promotion runs Monday to Friday from 11.30am to 3pm and is perfect for office workers tired of hawker centres.

1-for-1 Buffet Spreads: Several hotel buffets, including those at Carousel at Royal Plaza on Scotts and Lime at PARKROYAL COLLECTION Marina Bay, are running 1-for-1 lunch and dinner buffet promotions through the Chope app and various credit card deals. DBS, UOB and Citibank cardholders can save up to 50 per cent on two-person dining, with bookings often required at least 24 hours in advance.

Warehouse Sales And Beauty Bazaars

Outdoor Venture Warehouse Sale: Outdoor adventurers can stock up on discounted camping, hiking and trekking gear at the Outdoor Venture warehouse sale, running at their Tai Seng facility through the weekend. Expect 30 to 70 per cent off last-season items from brands like The North Face, Jack Wolfskin, Columbia and local favourites. Opening hours are 10am to 7pm daily, and payment is by cash, NETS or credit card.

BeautyFresh Beauty Bazaar: Beauty fans should head down to the BeautyFresh Beauty Bazaar at Takashimaya Square, running from 23 to 27 April. The bazaar features discounts of up to 60 per cent on premium skincare, haircare and fragrance brands, including Clarins, SK-II, Estee Lauder, Dyson and Oribe. BeautyFresh members enjoy an additional 10 per cent off, and shoppers who spend above \$300 in a single receipt receive a complimentary gift set worth up to \$120.

Travel And Cruise Promotions

Royal Caribbean Roadshow At Suntec: The cruise line is running its latest roadshow at Suntec City Level 1 Atrium through 27 April, offering exclusive early-bird rates for Quantum of the Seas and Anthem of the Seas sailings departing Singapore between June 2026 and March 2027. Early-bird bookings include complimentary onboard credits of up to \$300, kids-sail-free promotions for selected cabin categories, and reduced deposits of just \$100 per person. Many Singapore families find the short three-to-five-night sailings to nowhere or Penang itineraries particularly appealing for school holidays.

Banking And Finance Offers

State Bank of India Singapore Fixed Deposit Rates: SBI Singapore has revised its fixed deposit rates upward, with promotional rates of 3.25 per cent per annum for six-month tenures and 3.10 per cent for 12-month tenures, subject to a minimum placement of S\$20,000. The rates are among the highest currently advertised by retail banks in Singapore, although customers should note that SBI deposits are insured up to \$100,000 per depositor under the Singapore Deposit Insurance Corporation scheme. Rate promotions typically last a few weeks, so lock in before they revise downward.

DBS And UOB Credit Card Rebates: DBS Live Fresh cardholders earn 10 per cent cashback on online shopping and food delivery categories this month, capped at \$75, while UOB One cardholders continue to enjoy up to \$300 quarterly cash rebates when they hit the minimum spend of \$2,000 across three consecutive months. Both cards remain popular choices for Singaporeans looking to maximise everyday rewards without paying hefty annual fees.

Tips For Making The Most Of These Deals

With so many promotions running simultaneously, savvy shoppers should prioritise deals with the shortest validity windows first. Bazaars and warehouse sales typically offer the steepest discounts but end within days, while food app deals often refresh weekly. Stack credit card promotions with merchant discounts where possible, and always check terms and conditions for blackout dates or exclusions.
