



Singapore Lions Hyundai Cup 2026: Results and Fixtures

Description

Singapore opened the 2026 ASEAN Hyundai Cup with a 2-1 win over Cambodia and next host Timor-Leste at Jalan Besar Stadium on 27 July. Shawal Anuar scored before half-time, Sovann Ouk equalised for Cambodia in the 55th minute, and Ilhan Fandi delivered Singapore's winner deep in added time, according to [CNA's match report](#).

This is the canonical Lions campaign hub for a Singapore supporter checking results, remaining fixtures and what qualification requires. The ASEAN Football Federation's [official competition page](#) controls the schedule and group format; kick-off details can change.

Singapore's Group A campaign

The AFF table publishes local venue times: Cambodia's opener at 7pm, Vietnam at 8pm and the Singapore home games at 7pm and 9pm. Cambodia and Vietnam are one hour behind Singapore in July, so the first two away kick-offs convert to 8pm and 9pm Singapore time. These conversions are LBRD calculations; the live broadcaster listing controls.

What the opening win changes

Three points are a strong start, but the manner of the 2-1 result argues against treating Timor-Leste as a formality. Singapore led, were pulled level and needed a very late winner. The reader task is therefore to distinguish points already banked from performance questions still open.

This is analysis of the verified result and schedule, not a prediction of qualification.

The points-path calculator

The top two teams in each five-team group progress to two-legged semi-finals. With three points secured, three illustrative remaining paths are:

- **Two wins:** six more points produce at least nine total.
- **One win and one draw:** four more points produce at least seven total.
- **Three draws:** three more points produce six total.

These totals do not guarantee a finishing position. Opponent results, goal difference and tournament tie-break rules matter. The value of the calculation is to show why every remaining game has a distinct job: consolidate against Timor-Leste, limit damage or gain points in Hanoi, then use the Indonesia home game according to the live table.

Opponent-by-opponent task

Timor-Leste: turn possession into an early advantage

Timor-Leste qualified by beating Brunei 6â??1 on aggregate, so they reached Group A through competitive matches rather than a ceremonial place. Singapore need patience without allowing a slow start to turn into crowd anxiety.

Vietnam: protect the centre and value transitions

Vietnam are defending champions and were drawn as Group Aâ??s seeded side. An away match in Hanoi is not a useful place for vague â??must-winâ?? rhetoric. The task is to manage territory, set pieces and counterattacking moments while preserving game state.

Indonesia: prepare for a possible qualification decider

The final group match at Jalan Besar may carry direct table consequences. The correct tactical risk will depend on points and goal difference after 3 August, not on a preview written weeks earlier.

How to watch in Singapore

Mediacorp's [mewatch Hyundai Cup hub](#) is the official domestic digital route and includes full-match and highlights collections. Confirm account, device and stream availability before kick-off rather than troubleshooting at 7pm. The AFF announced that all 28 tournament matches would be broadcast across the region, but territory rights differ.

Matchday checklist

- Open the AFF fixture page for the current time and venue.
- Use mewatch's event hub for the Singapore broadcast route.
- Check official ticketing for Jalan Besar; do not rely on resale claims.
- Read the live table before deciding what result Singapore needs.
- Separate confirmed results from supporter predictions and social clips.

Sources re-opened 26 July 2026. The Cambodia result is traced to CNA's stadium report; schedule and format are traced to AFF; broadcast availability is traced to mewatch. LBRD did not attend the match and labels its scenario analysis and time conversions.

Opening-match evidence file

Keep the result separate from interpretation. The fixed match record is Cambodia 1-2 Singapore, with Shawal Anuar's opener, Sovann Ouk's equaliser and Ilhan Fandi's added-time winner. The analytical layer is that Singapore found a response after losing the lead. It does not establish that late goals will recur or that the team has solved every control problem.

LBRD live-update protocol

1. After each match, confirm the score and scorers against a stadium report or official match centre.
2. Update points by adding three for a win, one for a draw and zero for a loss.
3. Recalculate the remaining path without calling any total mathematically safe until the live table and tie-breakers support it.
4. Preserve the original publication date and use the modified date for genuine result updates.

This protocol is an original records workflow. It guards against a common tournament error: updating a headline while leaving an old fixture table or qualification claim in the body.

Before the Timor-Leste home match

Fans should verify the 7pm Singapore kick-off, authorised ticket status and Jalan Besar entry instructions on official channels. A home venue does not guarantee walk-up inventory. Viewers using

mewatch should open the live event page early enough to handle login, device and connection issues.

On the football side, compare the first 20 minutes with the Cambodia match: does Singapore establish territory without becoming vulnerable in transition? That is a specific observation task, not a claim about the coach's intended tactics.

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
