Elsewhere across the precinct, catch *Our Songs, Our Stories*, a community singalong of Xinyao and SG music with CAPITAL 958's DJ line-up; *A Date with Tradition 2026* at Stamford Arts Centre; *All Things Singapore* at the National Library Building and National Archives; and SMU Arts Fest's outdoor shadow-puppetry production *Once Upon an Island*, which reimagines the founding of Singapura, the Redhill swordfish legend and the legend of Kusu Island.

Singapore Night Festival 2026 runs until 5 September across the Bras Basah Bugis precinct, with most programmes free to attend. A social-media giveaway also continues, with limited-edition SNF merchandise up for grabs for festival-goers who track down the Legend on the final Saturday.
