



Snow City Singapore Closing September 2026: Final June Holiday Visit Guide

Description

Snow City Singapore closing September 2026 is the goodbye most of us did not see coming. The Jurong East indoor snow centre has been Singapore's go-to winter playground since the year 2000. After 26 years of subzero giggles, the snow doors are finally shutting after the September holidays. This is your last legit chance to introduce the kids to real snow before the lights go out.

Yes, you read that right. Singapore's first indoor snow attraction is wrapping up its final season. The June school holidays are the natural moment to make the trip, before crowds spike in August and September.

Why Snow City Singapore Is Closing September 2026

Science Centre Singapore confirmed that Snow City will cease operations after September 2026. The site is part of the wider Science Centre Singapore precinct, which is moving to a new home near Chinese Garden MRT. The current Jurong East building will be redeveloped, and Snow City does not get a refreshed slot in the new masterplan.

For three generations of Singaporean kids, this little ice box has been the closest thing to a white Christmas in the tropics. Easties, Westies and everyone in between have shown up for school excursions, birthdays and casual lepak weekends. Closing month is September 2026 â?? but the smart move is to book now.

What To Ride Before Snow City Singapore Closes

Bring the family for a final spin on the signature attractions. The 60-metre snow slope is the headline ride – wide enough for parents and toddlers to share a snow tube without breaking a sweat. Save energy for the secondary zones too, since farewell visits do not get a do-over.

- **Snow Slope** – 60-metre, 3-storey indoor slope with snow tubes. The OG experience.
- **Glacier Luge** – a faster, twistier ride for the older kids and FOMO adults.
- **P. Snowhouse** – themed igloo-style photo zone, perfect for the family year-end card.
- **Snow Play Area** – open-floor snowball action for toddlers and primary schoolers.
- **Shaman’s Souvenir Shop** – grab a final keepsake before stocks run out.

Snow City Singapore Tickets, Hours And Closing Timeline

Snow City operates daily timed-entry sessions, typically from 10am to 6pm. Each session runs about two hours, including kit-up time for jackets and boots. Walk-ins are accepted, but kiasu parents should book online to lock in their slot during the June holidays.

- **Address:** 21 Jurong Town Hall Road, Singapore 609433.
- **Nearest MRT:** Jurong East â?? about 10 minutesâ?? walk via the Science Centre.
- **Standard admission:** from S\$20 per child and S\$22 per adult (online price).
- **Closing month:** September 2026 â?? exact final day to be confirmed by Snow City.
- **Pro tip:** book a morning session â?? the snow is freshest and queues are shortest.

Tips For A Smooth Final Visit

Dress smart underneath because temperatures inside hover around minus five degrees Celsius. Long pants and socks are mandatory â?? no exceptions. Snow City lends out the jacket, gloves and boots, so you do not need to splurge on actual ski gear.

Photographers, this one will not last long. Sentimental shots inside the igloo zone and at the top of the snow slope are the obvious keepers. Bookmark this and plan the trip before the final session sells out.
