



SSO National Day Concert 2026: Pick a Seat and Plan the Night

Description

The SSO National Day Concert is on Saturday, 15 August 2026 at 7.30pm in Esplanade Concert Hall. Tickets are S\$15, S\$30, S\$40, S\$55 and S\$75, and the published duration is 90 minutes without an intermission. This guide is for a resident choosing whether and how to attend the 2026 sso national day concert and resolves one task: choose a ticket band, understand the Singapore-composer focus and plan arrival. The material claims were checked against [SSO National Day Concert page](#) and [Esplanade event page](#).

Choose the route that matches your case

Situation	What to do
Budget is the priority	Start with the S\$15 and S\$30 ticket bands
View and sound balance matters	Open the live seat map before payment
Audience member needs a break	Note the 90-minute no-intermission format
Using SG Culture Pass	Confirm eligibility and checkout treatment live

Start with the programme idea

The concert brings together Singapore composers across generations and includes winning works from the 2026 call for compositions. According to [SSO National Day Concert page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

This is not a generic patriotic medley listing; read the live programme notes before the night.

Choose price and seat together

Five published price bands run from S\$15 to S\$75. According to [Esplanade event page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

A lower price can still suit the listener if the seat map and accessibility work.

Plan for no intermission

The duration is about one hour 30 minutes without an interval. According to [SSO National Day Concert page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

Use facilities and settle children or mobility needs before doors close.

Arrive with margin

Esplanade security, ticket collection and hall seating take time. According to [Esplanade event page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

Set an arrival target at least 30 minutes before the performance and check the ticket instructions.

Use responsible concert etiquette

Silence devices and follow photography guidance. According to [SSO National Day Concert page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

Late seating may be restricted to suitable breaks determined by the venue.

Extend the cultural value

Read one paragraph about each featured composer and note one work to listen for. According to [Esplanade event page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

After the concert, record which musical idea felt specifically connected to Singapore and why.

Run the numbers or sequence

Two S\$30 tickets cost S\$60 before any stated booking charge. A practical night plan adds transport, a 30-minute arrival buffer and a post-concert meeting point.

The calculation or sequence above is an LBRD working example. Replace every example input with the amount, date, access condition or document from your own case. Keep the official rate or threshold beside the working so another person can reproduce the answer.

Build a verification note another person can check

Before acting, create a one-page case note headed with the task, the date checked and the person responsible. Copy only the facts that affect your decision, then attach the statement, booking,

application, receipt, map record or screenshot that supplies your own input. This separates a published rule from a personal assumption. If the official page changes, keep the earlier dated record but rework the decision with the live version.

Controlling source	What to verify	What to retain
SSO National Day Concert page	Date, time, venue, prices, duration and Singapore-composer programme context.	Record the page date, the exact rule used and the case input it governs.
Esplanade event page	Venue presentation, access and ticketing context for the concert.	Record the page date, the exact rule used and the case input it governs.

Read the source in context, including definitions, exceptions and effective dates. A relevant page is not proof by itself: the cited passage must contain the particular rate, deadline, eligibility condition, access rule or warning used here. Where two official channels appear inconsistent, pause and ask the authority about the exact case rather than choosing the more convenient answer.

Use the guide with its limits

A useful museum visit is built around questions, not the number of display labels read. Choose the time budget, identify two objects or moments to examine closely, and leave a few minutes to connect them with the site and wider neighbourhood.

No interview, personal use, fresh field visit, survey result or price check is claimed unless explicitly stated. Availability, fees and procedures can change. Reopen the linked authority page immediately before payment, travel, filing or emergency use.

Before you act

1. Confirm 15 August date
2. Open the live seat map
3. Choose price band
4. Check access needs
5. Arrive 30 minutes early
6. Prepare for no intermission
7. Read current programme notes

Mistakes that change the outcome

- Assuming an interval
- Choosing on price alone
- Arriving at 7.30pm
- Using an old programme
- Ignoring late-seating rules

Questions readers ask

Which source controls this decision?

SSO National Day Concert page controls the main rule, with Esplanade event page used for the second check.

Can I use the worked example as my final figure?

No. Replace every input with your own dated record and confirm the live rule before acting.

What should I save?

Keep the official page date, your case inputs, the calculation or sequence, and the submission or payment acknowledgement.
