



## Sustainable Futures Film Festival 2026: Free ArtScience Cinema Guide

### Description

Sustainable Futures Film Festival 2026 gives ArtScience Museum visitors a free cinema option over the June-to-August stretch. The festival runs from 12 June to 31 August 2026 at ArtScience Cinema on Level 4.

The programme sits neatly beside ArtScience Museum's ocean and life-sciences programming because the films deal with climate, marine systems, future thinking and how people respond to environmental change.

## Films To Notice

The official visuals name titles including OceanXplorers and Future Council, signalling a programme that moves between ocean exploration, youth perspectives and practical questions about the future.

Because admission is free, the useful planning point is timing rather than price. Check the session time before heading down, especially if you are pairing the screening with a ticketed exhibition in the same building.
