



Suvarnabhumi Luggage Storage: Compare Size, Time and Receipt

Description

AOT lists Bellugg luggage storage at Suvarnabhumi on Levels 2 and 4. Published 24-hour prices are 100 baht under 22 inches, 120 baht for 22 to 26 inches and 150 baht above 26 inches; **recheck before deposit**. This guide is for a singapore traveller with a bangkok layover or hotel gap and resolves one task: calculate storage cost and preserve the receipt and collection plan. The material claims were checked against [AOT Bellugg booking page](#) and [AOT Bellugg facility page](#).

Choose the route that matches your case

Situation	What to do
Bag is under 22 inches	Use the published small-band price
Bag is 22 to 26 inches	Use the medium band
Bag exceeds 26 inches	Use the large band
Storage crosses another 24-hour period	Ask the counter how additional time is charged

Measure before pricing

Wheel, handle and hard-shell dimensions can affect the band. According to [AOT Bellugg booking page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

Photograph the measured bag and read the live counter tariff.

Count the full storage window

A few hours past a 24-hour boundary can change charging. According to [AOT Bellugg facility page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

Write deposit and latest collection time in Bangkok local time.

Choose the right terminal level

AOT lists counters on Levels 2 and 4. According to [AOT Bellugg booking page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

Map the counter from arrival, rail or departure flow before committing.

Keep the receipt

The facility page states the counter issues proof of deposit. According to [AOT Bellugg facility page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

Photograph it securely and do not post claim numbers publicly.

Remove critical items

Keep passport, medicines, valuables, batteries and boarding documents with you subject to aviation rules. According to [AOT Bellugg booking page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

Read prohibited and liability terms at the counter.

Build a collection buffer

Airport security, queues and terminal walking take time. According to [AOT Bellugg facility page](#), the controlling detail for this branch is the specific rule or service condition cited here.

Collect well before check-in and boarding cut-offs.

Run the numbers or sequence

One medium bag for up to 24 hours is listed at 120 baht. Two medium bags are 240 baht before any additional-period or service condition confirmed at deposit.

The calculation or sequence above is an LBRD working example. Replace every example input with the amount, date, access condition or document from your own case. Keep the official rate or threshold beside the working so another person can reproduce the answer.

Build a verification note another person can check

Before acting, create a one-page case note headed with the task, the date checked and the person responsible. Copy only the facts that affect your decision, then attach the statement, booking, application, receipt, map record or screenshot that supplies your own input. This separates a published rule from a personal assumption. If the official page changes, keep the earlier dated record but rework

the decision with the live version.

Controlling source	What to verify	What to retain
AOT Bellugg booking page	Counter levels, one-hour advance reservation and published size-based 24-hour prices.	Record the page date, the exact rule used and the case input it governs.
AOT Bellugg facility page	Airport storage service and deposit-receipt process.	Record the page date, the exact rule used and the case input it governs.

Read the source in context, including definitions, exceptions and effective dates. A relevant page is not proof by itself: the cited passage must contain the particular rate, deadline, eligibility condition, access rule or warning used here. Where two official channels appear inconsistent, pause and ask the authority about the exact case rather than choosing the more convenient answer.

Use the guide with its limits

Travel rules can change between booking and boarding. Check the competent authority, then the operating airline or border channel, and keep the dated confirmation offline. The officer or carrier applying the live rule remains decisive.

No interview, personal use, fresh field visit, survey result or price check is claimed unless explicitly stated. Availability, fees and procedures can change. Reopen the linked authority page immediately before payment, travel, filing or emergency use.

Before you act

1. Measure the bag
2. Open the live AOT page
3. Choose Level 2 or 4
4. Confirm the time basis
5. Remove critical items
6. Keep the receipt
7. Collect with flight buffer

Mistakes that change the outcome

- Ignoring wheels in size
- Assuming any partial day is free
- Losing the receipt
- Storing passport or medicine
- Collecting just before check-in closes

Which source controls this decision?

AOT Bellugg booking page controls the main rule, with AOT Bellugg facility page used for the second check.

Can I use the worked example as my final figure?

No. Replace every input with your own dated record and confirm the live rule before acting.

What should I save?

Keep the official page date, your case inputs, the calculation or sequence, and the submission or payment acknowledgement.
