



The Line DBS Buffet Deal: 20% Off At Shangri-La Singapore

Description

The Line DBS buffet deal gives eligible DBS and POSB cardholders up to 20% off lunch and dinner buffet at Shangri-La Singapore, and it is the kind of dining privilege that needs a careful read before you book. DBS lists 20% off for selected premium DBS cardholders and 15% off for other eligible DBS/POSB cardholders, with advance reservation required.

The official restaurant page describes The Line as an international buffet with 9 live stations, buffet lunch from 12pm to 2.30pm and buffet dinner from 6pm to 9.30pm. That matters because a buffet deal should never be judged only by the bank discount. You want to know the meal period, the restaurant's normal buffet proposition, the booking rules and whether exclusions affect your date.

The most practical way to judge the meal is to price the actual table you are booking: number of adults, number of children, meal period and whether the eligible DBS card is in hand. Once those facts are clear, the discount becomes a real estimate rather than a percentage floating above the restaurant page.

Key Details



The Line at Shangri-La Singapore is the restaurant named in the DBS dining privilege.

The DBS page states that the promotion runs until 30 December 2026. To enjoy the offer, diners must quote "DBS2026" during reservation. The higher 20% tier applies to DBS Insignia, DBS Treasures Black Elite, DBS Vantage and DBS World Cardmembers, while the page also lists a 15% buffet discount.

The offer applies to adult buffet pricing only. Children aged 6 to 11 dine at 50% of the adult original price, while children below 6 dine free with every paying adult, according to the DBS terms.

The discount is not valid on eve of public holidays, public holidays and celebratory occasions such as Mother's Day, Father's Day and Easter. Shangri-La Circle points also cannot be earned from this promotion.

Buffet Spread To Expect



The Line is known for its international buffet spread and live stations.

The official Shangri-La page positions The Line around “Flavours of the World” and 9 live stations. That is the important restaurant-side detail missing from many quick deal listings: this is not just a card discount on a generic meal, but a buffet format built around variety and stations.

The venue's buffet lunch and dinner periods make it easier to choose the right timing. Lunch works better for families or groups who want a shorter outing, while dinner usually suits celebrations and slower meals.

Because buffet offerings can change by date and season, confirm the current menu when reserving. The DBS privilege gives the card terms; the restaurant page gives the dining context.

How To Claim

Chef Jin Hong is listed by Shangri-La Singapore for The Line.

Reserve in advance with The Line and quote "DBS2026". Bring and pay with a valid DBS/POSB credit or debit card. If you are relying on the 20% tier, use the exact eligible card listed by DBS rather than assuming every DBS card qualifies.

Ask the restaurant to confirm whether your date is excluded before finalising plans. This is especially important around public holidays, hotel celebration periods and family occasions.

For groups, check whether the discount applies to the whole adult bill and whether any children's pricing or special menus are treated differently. A short confirmation call can prevent awkward bill-side surprises.

Mei Chua's Dining Deal Take

This is a solid deal if you already wanted a hotel buffet and can book outside blackout dates. The best value comes from matching the discount to a meal you would genuinely enjoy, not stretching the group just because a percentage is available.

The Line's appeal is variety, so it suits groups with mixed preferences. If everyone wants the same specific cuisine, an à la carte restaurant may still be the better meal.

For families, the children's terms are worth reading closely because a buffet bill changes quickly when adult and child prices are mixed. Confirm the final estimate before treating the discount as the whole story.

Booking Verdict

Use the The Line DBS buffet deal if you can book an eligible date, pay with the right DBS/POSB card and make full use of the buffet format. Quote the promo code at reservation, then confirm blackout dates and child pricing before the meal.

The discount is useful, but the restaurant fit matters just as much. A hotel buffet works best when the group wants variety, time to linger and a central Singapore setting.
