



Things to do this weekend in Singapore (25-27 September 2026)

Description

Mid-Autumn Festival falls on **Friday, 25 September 2026**, and Singapore packs lantern trails, free precincts and ticketed nights into **Friday to Sunday, 25 to 27 September**. Halloween Horror Nights opens Friday and Saturday only this weekend, not Sunday.
