



Tides Of Time At Singapore Maritime Gallery: Free Weekend Tour Guide

Description

Tides of Time: Exploring Singapore's Maritime Story is a free guided session at the Singapore Maritime Gallery. It runs on selected weekends from 15 March to 31 December 2026, with the event page listing a 2.30pm to 3.30pm timing.

The tour is useful for families, students and visitors who want a structured introduction to Singapore's port history without paying for a museum ticket.

It is also a good rainy-day backup if you are already travelling to Marina South Pier, because the gallery is indoors and the one-hour format is easier to fit around ferry timings.

What The Tour Covers

The Eventbrite listing says participants trace Singapore's maritime story from the 3rd century to modern global supply chains. It also highlights the 1603 Santa Catarina incident and rare archaeological artefacts from shipwrecks.

MPA's Singapore Maritime Gallery page describes the gallery as a place to understand Singapore's maritime heritage, the link between shipping and daily life, and how technology keeps the sector future-ready.

- Date range: 15 March to 31 December 2026.
- Time: 2.30pm to 3.30pm on selected weekends.
- Cost: complimentary, first-come-first-served tickets.
- Meeting point: Marina South Pier, Level 2.

The tour starts and ends at Singapore Maritime Gallery, Marina South Pier Level 2.

How To Plan It

Arrive 15 minutes before the session because the listing notes that sessions may depend on minimum participant numbers and ticket availability. The nearest MRT station is Marina South Pier, Exit B.

Parking is limited at Marina South Pier, so public transport is the cleaner option. If you are pairing the tour with the Southern Islands ferries, leave enough buffer because the gallery is upstairs from the pier flow.
