



## World Cities Summit 2026: Free Trade Visitor Pass Guide

### Description

World Cities Summit 2026 runs in Singapore from 14 to 16 June, and the useful update for working professionals is the availability of a Trade Visitor Pass.

The pass gives access to the WCS Exhibition and up to three WCS sessions or masterclasses across the Summit days at no charge. That makes the event relevant beyond mayors and delegates; urban planners, built-environment teams, consultants and students can still get value from a targeted visit.

### What The Pass Covers

The Trade Visitor Pass is designed for exhibition access plus a limited number of Summit sessions or masterclasses. It is the practical choice for readers who want to understand city trends without buying a full delegate package.

- Summit dates: 14 to 16 June 2026.
- Trade Visitor Pass: exhibition access plus up to three WCS sessions or masterclasses.
- Themes include smart cities, future cities, financing, resilience and cities for people.
- The WCS web app is live for planning the schedule.



The Summit programme includes exhibition access and selected sessions for trade visitors.

## Who Should Consider Going

The best audience is anyone working around urban policy, property, infrastructure, architecture, transport, climate resilience or city technology. Students in planning, real estate or public policy can also use the exhibition as a compact networking and learning stop.

Because the pass is limited by session count, pick sessions before registering instead of arriving with a blank calendar.



The 2026 edition focuses on city leadership, resilience, financing and future-city themes.

## Professional Development Notes

The Summit lists professional-development recognition for selected groups, including BOA-SIA CPD, SILA CPD, SIP CPD and PEB PDU points by day. That makes the timing especially useful for built-environment professionals tracking annual learning requirements.

If you only have a half day, prioritise the exhibition floor and one high-fit session rather than trying to skim the full programme.

Before registering, write down the three sessions that match your work or study goals. The free pass is most useful when it leads to targeted conversations, not when the day becomes a general walk through every booth.
