A same-day event note for readers heading to Suntec or deciding whether the qualifier is worth a spectator stop.

- Date: Saturday, 23 May 2026.
- Venue: Suntec Singapore Convention & Exhibition Centre.
- Suntec lists the event from 10am to 10pm.
- The event title is Yu-Gi-Oh! World Championship 2026 Qualifier English Edition for Asia (Singapore).
- Visitors should expect a trading-card-game crowd rather than a general consumer fair.

Who Should Pay Attention

This is most useful for readers who need a clear, local decision: whether to book, visit, budget, apply, compare or set aside time before the window passes. The practical details matter more than the headline, especially when venues, age suitability, minimum spend, ticketing or dates affect the plan.

Planning Notes

If you are heading down in a group, settle the transport route and timing first. For Suntec events, City Hall, Esplanade and Promenade are the usual MRT options. For Mandai, build in road travel time. For museum and dining visits, check admission, booking or reservation rules before leaving home.
